

- ✓ COPRAR DISCHARGE TO BE IMPLEMENTED






During the development of the COPRAR DISCHARGE exchange, which information do they need to include ?


- > A process can help them analyze their needs and requirements
- ✓ COPRAR DISCHARGE TO INCLUDE TRANSSHIPMENT INFORMATION. TERMINAL AND SHIPPING LINE CAN CHOOSE WHICH BUSINESS CASE TO AGREE ON.

- > GEFEG FX Is the link between our MIG and the validation portal
- ✓ TERMINAL AND / OR SHIPPING LINE TEST THE FILE IN THE VALIDATION PORTAL
